#### Things to consider as a Point Boston resident:

Point Boston is a beautiful part of the Eyre Peninsula. It is also in a fire prone area which could present some specific threats during a bushfire.

It's always best to prepare your family and property **BEFORE** bushfire season. Have a plan, practice it, test your equipment and know what to do if there is a fire nearby.

#### Remember:

- Sullivan Drive is the only way in, and out, for residents. It's also the only way in for CFS
- The closest CFS station is over 10 minutes away in North Shields. They only have one fire truck, which may already be at another incident if we have a fire threatening Point Boston.
- There is absolutely no guarantee that fire trucks, or aircraft, will be available to fight a fire threatening Point Boston
- Understand the emergency warnings framework
- Download the AlertSA app
- Subscribe to alerts

NB: All duties are weather permitting and may or may not happen within the month indicated above.

#### **OVERVIEW OF GROUNDMAN DUTIES**

- Ride on mowing/spraying common areas, swales, vacant blocks, road edges, walking trails, around buildings and fire breaks and Green Shed (sand mine area, Peninsula Club gully, evaporation pits, Sullivan Drive, absorbs beds.
- Whipper Snipping high vegetation areas not accessible by ride on mower.
- **Trimming** Walking trails, road edges, swales & verges, Green Shed, evaporation pits, absorbs beds, Sullivan Drive, fire breaks, fallen trees around community centre and fence lines.
- Invasive Species Control (Spraying) Aleppo Pine, White Weeping Broom, African Box Thorn, Horehound, Onion Weed, African Daisy, Bridal Creeper, Paddy Melons, Tobacco Weed, Spiny Rush
- Inspections waste water, water meters at community centre & control panel at absorb beds.
- Collect Rubbish through precinct & Sullivan Drive.
- Checks for Maintenance water leaks, waste water leaks, vandalism, structural & fence lines, gates, roads, signs, power boxes, service & check fire equipment, clear drains & swales, check evaporation pits (buoys & signs).
- Rabbit Control fumigate warrens, final warren clear for access (trimming), Pindone control & general checks.
- Fox Control fox baits, fumigate warrens.
- **Cat Control** cat traps monitored, re-bait and strategically positioned.
- Rodent Control bait in structural areas (ie, Community Hall and Green Sheds).

#### **Point Boston Mains Water Supply**

The East Bay Community is committed to improving water efficiency and supporting the sustainable use of drinking water.

Rainwater tanks are required to be the **primary drinking water supply** source and to have a mains supplementary drinking water connection as a back-up supply. The objective is for the East Bay Estate to be partially independent of mains drinking water system.

All residential buildings within East Bay Estate must collect and make maximum use of rainwater. Each property should capture, store, filter and disinfect its own rainwater to be used on that property

To future-proof East Bay's mains drinking water supply, we must comply with the By-laws, which require the Corporation to maintain a minimum water level in household tanks during periods of low rainfall. Since the March 2022 plumbing guideline changes, mains water for household tanks is limited to a **0.4 L/min trickle feed** via a flow controller, and fire tanks to **2.8 L/min**. Garden taps must connect to rainwater pumps (Owners may install a separate tank for toilets, washing machines and garden taps if they do not wish to mix SA Water with rainwater)

The original estate design intended homes to rely primarily on rainwater tanks, with no direct mains connection except through trickle feeds when the tanks become low.

Moving forward, all new homes will have the **10 L/min flow controllers** installed at their meter connection, a rollout for existing homes is eventually planned for the future. As Point Boston grows future committees will need to assess options for upgrading the Sullivan Drive supply main, in consultation with SA Water and also investigating available grants to support improvements to our water supply network.

Please remember that there are no restrictions on how much mains water you can use, you may use as much as you are willing to pay for. When connected correctly to your pump system, there should be no issues with water pressure.

This approach ensures a fairer and more reliable water distribution system for everyone, as some users currently experience low or no water supply during peak usage periods.

#### The minimum total volume of rainwater tanks required for each dwelling is:

Runoff from all roof areas on the allotment shall be collected in interconnected rainwater tanks. The rainwater tank shall be equipped with an electric pump, cartridge micro filter and UV disinfection unit to supply all drinking water quality requirements. Refence: Design Guidelines 2022, Appendix 1, 1.2.1

There is no maximum volume amount of rainwater tanks you can have.

Don't forget to check your User Guide about how often you should change the filter/s cartridge and UV light, normally it's approximately every 12 months.
